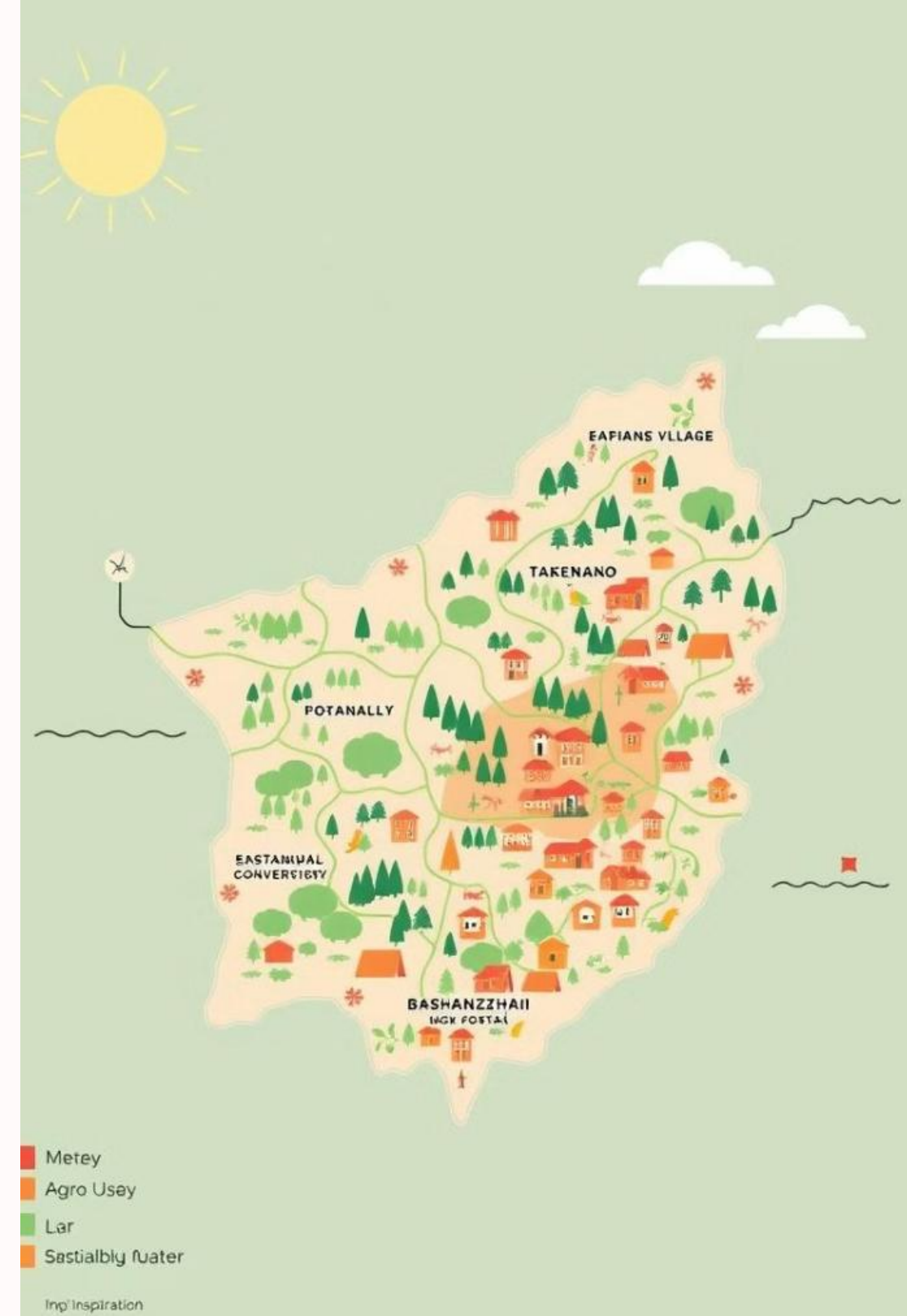
Promoting Agroforestry

Modernizing Agricultural Practices



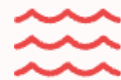
Mechanization

Local Craft Production

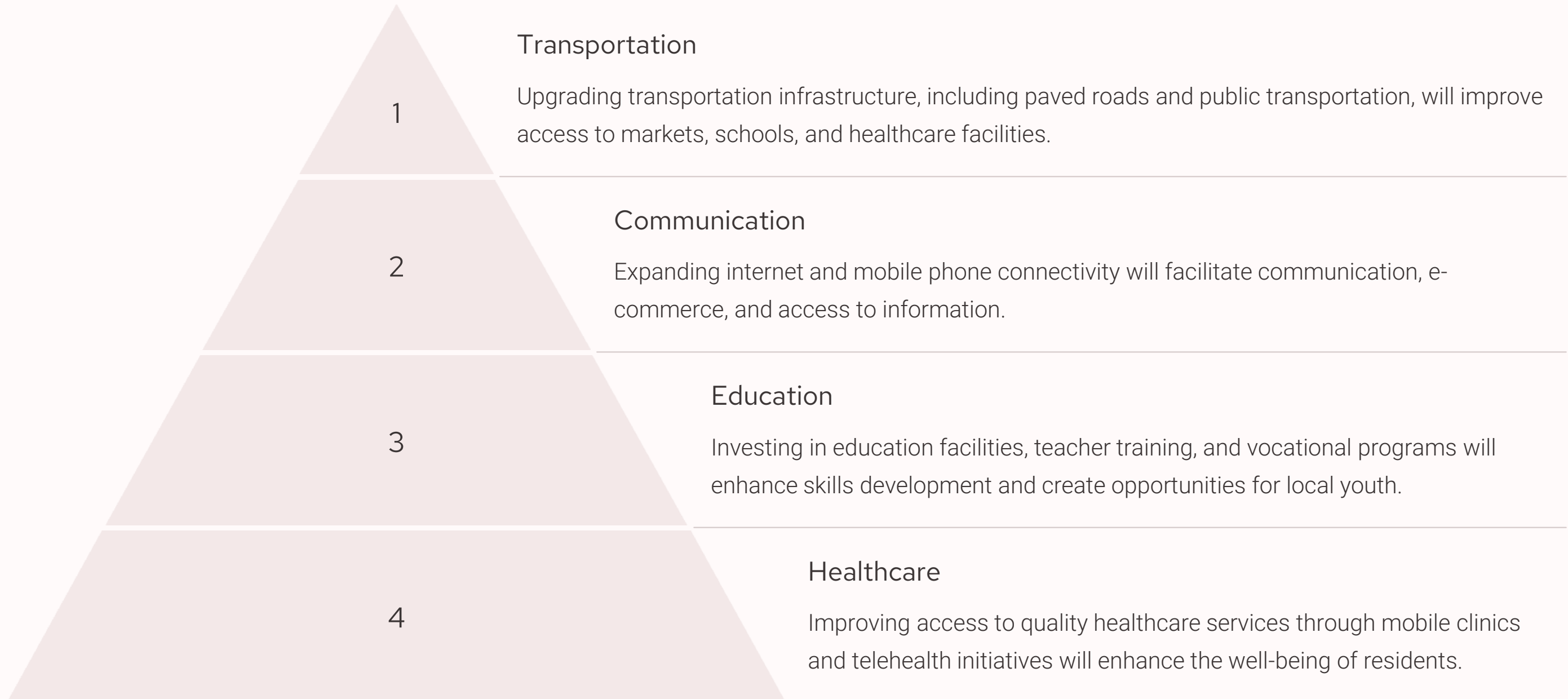
Encouraging the revival of traditional crafts and artisan products will create new income opportunities and preserve local cultural heritage.
